**Minutes** The Minutes of the previous meeting, having been circulated, after the insertion of Mr.Digwood as being present, were taken as read and signed as a correct record.

**Matters arising from those minutes**

It was noted that Mrs.Thompson had not attended a meeting during the past six months. The clerk was instructed to contact her and clarify the position with her.

**Website manager** The clerk would contact Mr.Justin White for more information.

**Parish Council vacancy** There had been no call for an election to fill the vacancy and the Parish Council was therefore able to co-opt a new Member. Mr.John Cantrill had shown interest and was duly co-opted to the Council. He was given a Declaration of Interest form to complete.

**Reports** **County Councillor** Cllr.Tindall said that Cllr.Cecelia Motley had spoken to him about the Planning application at the Acton Arms and asked Councillors to decide whether or not they wished him to 'call in' the application. He also reported that although a developer was interested, the sale of the former Bridgnorth District Council site at Westgate had been put on hold as the Police had announced their intention of selling the Police Station. Regarding the future funding of the Lengthsman, there was no information available at present.

**Highways**

Defects were reported on Acton Round Bank where the non-slip surface needed to be replaced and the deep rut from the side of the carriage way to the

verge. Potholes had appeared between Meadowley and Upper House Farm and on the Underdon Lane where there was also a deep rut.

Application 16/03424/FUL Erection of agricultural building at Great Oxenbold Farm, Weston, Much Wenlock. There were no objections

Application No.16/02571/FUL Erection of single storey oak framed garden room at East Farm, Underdon. There were no objections

Application 16/03057/FUL Erection of two storey rear extension at 82 Haughton Cottages, Haughton, Bridgnorth. There were no objections

Reconsultation due to amendment on application 15/00304/FUL - Land to the rear of The Acton Arms, Morville, erection of 6 detached houses, access, parking and landscaping. The amendment to the original application was discussed but Councillors remained strongly concerned about flooding and the difficult access. The clerk was instructed to *construct* a reply and send it to Councillors for their approval or amendment before submitting it to the Planning Officer. Cllr Tindall would be sent a copy of the reply.
