

## **At a meeting of Morville Parish Council held on Monday, 14th November 2016 .**

**Public participation** Mr.Richard Hall of Brook House, Monkhopton, outlined his plans to apply for a Single Exception Plot home at Beacon Hill. He asked for the Parish Council's support in his residency statement.

**Minutes** The Minutes of the previous meeting, having been circulated, were taken as read, confirmed and signed as a correct record.

### **Matters arising from those minutes**

Mrs.Thompson had been contacted and it appeared that she had not been receiving Notices of the meetings. The clerk had discovered that during the late summer, her computer was maliciously 'hacked' and Councillors from other Parish Councils had not received mail from her. The clerk had taken legal advice and it was agreed that Mrs.Thompson should continue as a Councillor.

**Parish Council vacancy** Mr.Clive Millington had sent a letter of resignation to the Council. As it was less than six months from Council elections in May it was not necessary to advertise the vacancy. The Chairman would speak to Mr.Tim Morris who had previously shown interest in becoming a Councillor.

**Reports** **County Councillor** In Cllr.Tindall's absence, the following report was read -

1. As requested I have asked if the planning application for the development behind the Acton Arms could come before committee. However I do not yet know if it will.
2. No cap on Parish Council precept unless it is in excess of £1/2 million.
3. Lengthsmen grant preserved for 2017/2018 but not sure what is going to happen thereafter when the Ringway contract expires
4. Court of Appeal has upheld Brandon Lewis ministerial statement mad in November 2014 that developments of ten or less dwellings (five or less in AONBs) do not necessarily have to pay s.106 agreement payments
