Approval for Application No.16/04806, conversion of redundant agricultural barn to residential dwelling at Weston House Weston Much Wenlock TF13 6QT.

Application 16/05556/FUL Erection of triple garage and store at Keepers Cottage, Bourton, Much Wenlock, Shropshire No objection in principal but had reservations about the excessive size of the proposal.

Application 16/05522/FUL Erection of first floor rear extension at Tiddlebrook Cottage, Telegraph Lane, Bridgnorth. There were no objections.

- b) Consideration of Parish Precept 2016/17 The clerk had produced information which had been circulated to Members.
