

## At Morville Annual Parish meeting held on 18th May 2015

Minutes The Minutes of the previous Annual Parish Meeting having been circulated were taken as read, confirmed and signed as a correct record.

Matters Arising There were no matters arising from the Minutes

Reports Chairman : The Chairman said it had been a busy year regarding planning with several significant applications including one for Wind Turbines. The poor condition of the roads had caused concern especially at Aston Eyre and Beaconhill and talks were taking place regarding the installation of traffic calming measures. The Chairman then thanked Mr.Tart for his work in relation to the school field and retired Councillors Bridget Chappuis and Hazel Harrison. He then formally welcomed Cllr.R.Pugh and Cllr. Judy Miles to the Parish Council and thanked all Councillors and the clerk for their support.

Shropshire Councillor : Cllr Tindall reported that a reorganisation of planning committees was being considered by Councillors. Councillors had discussed the proposals at a Task and Finish group meeting and before making a decision, had agreed to invite comments from Parish Councillors. Cllr.Tindall then answered questions regarding Planning and also said that the SAMDev plan for Shropshire, had not yet been formally accepted.

Village Hall Miss Alderson gave a full report on the Village Hall activities over the past twelve months. She mentioned the purchase of new curtains, maintenance work on the floor and the exterior of the building. Particular thanks were offered to the Parish Council for their assistance in purchasing the defibrillator.

Responsible Finance Officer The RFO spoke about the election re-charge which had been imposed on the Parish. Donations had been made to the purchase of a defibrillator, the Morville News and Air Ambulance. Shropshire Council had again made a grant of £3000 towards the work of the Parish Lengthsman and the invaluable work he carried out in the narrow lanes right across the Parish.
